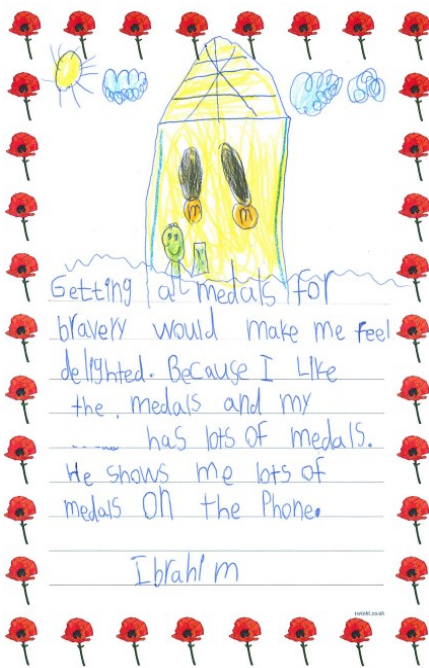

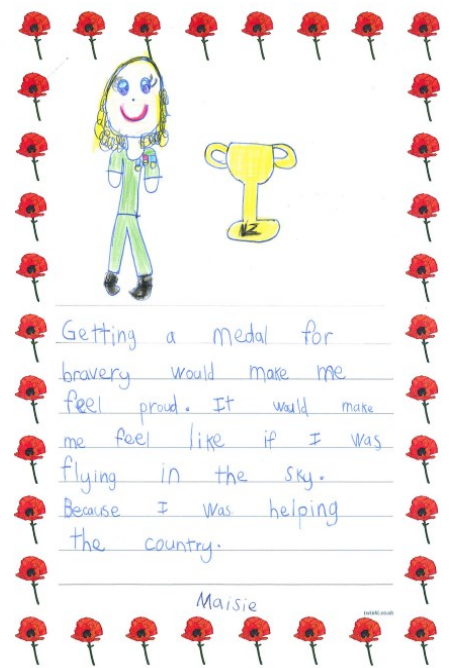
Getting lots of medals for
