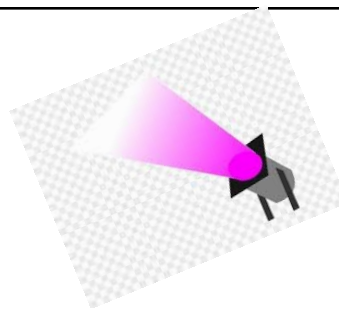
I hope these words have inspired you too.
