Welbourn is surrounded by busy roads, so for the safety of all of our tamariki it is important that everyone follows the road rules and uses the pedestrian crossing.

Coronation Ave Crossing is patrolled by Highlands in the morning between 8.15 and 8.45am the by Welbourn in the afternoon from 2.55 and 3.15pm.

Cumberland St crossing is patrolled by Welbourn in the morning between 8.30 and 8.50am and the afternoon from 2.55 and 3.15pm.

If your child is walking to or from school please make sure they are within these patrolled crossing times. If they need to use the crossing outside of these times it means they will be crossing by themselves.

Teachers have been discussing safe crossing practices this week, please reinforce this message at home with your child.
