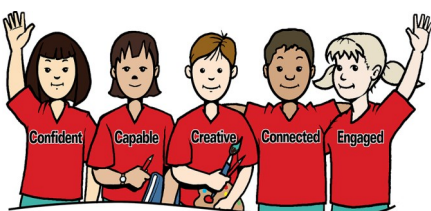

Working together with you to grow our learners social and emotional skills in support of their wellbeing (including behaviour management), is something we value at Welbourn. Your input is crucial. You will find some ideas and resources appearing in our newsletters throughout the rest of the year.

To start off we have found out about an effective relationship building strategy which we would like you to try - some of you will already be doing this we're sure.

"**TWO** by **TEN**". This is a formally researched way to ensure that the connection is positive and gives the children the feeling of security and connection they need.

For 2 minutes a day for 10 days — stop, put all electronics off and away and talk (using eye contact) with your child, actively listening to them. Consistency is the key. Not making it longer, but ensuring that it happens everyday.

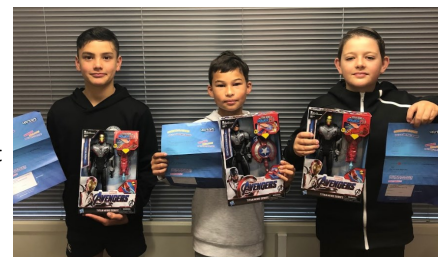
