## Student Attendance

Schools, along with parents and guardians, are responsible for making sure students attend school regularly.

The Education and Training Act 2020 requires that all children six years old and over must attend school. Once enrolled, it is compulsory for children to attend school regularly. 90% or greater attendance is considered to be regular attendance.

We monitor the daily attendance of students to:

- ensure their safety both in getting to school, and in accounting for them in an emergency
- identify students with achievement, engagement, or other issues
- meet our legal responsibilities

It is also important that children are arriving at school on time each day. Before the start of the day (8.30 - 8.50am) is an important time for children to socialise and prepare for the day's learning. Arriving after 8.50am can be detrimental to their learning and social development.

## SCOOTER & BIKE SKILLS

This week saw the start of our schoolwide scooter & bike skills training with the Let's Go Team. The Tui, Pukeko & Weka Teams, all completed their scooter skills session. Next week our Kakapo Team will have their bike skills training.

The key messages from the scooter skills were:

- Make sure you have a helmet that fits properly and it is worn whenever riding a scooter (or bike, roller blades, skateboard etc)
- Your scooter is safe with working brakes
- Stay in control—know your ability level & know how to STOP when needed
- Be aware of potential hazards (sneaky driveways, hills, pedestrians, cars, footpath surfaces etc)

Please chat with your child so they can share their learning and make time to practice and reinforce the skills.
