Mathathon

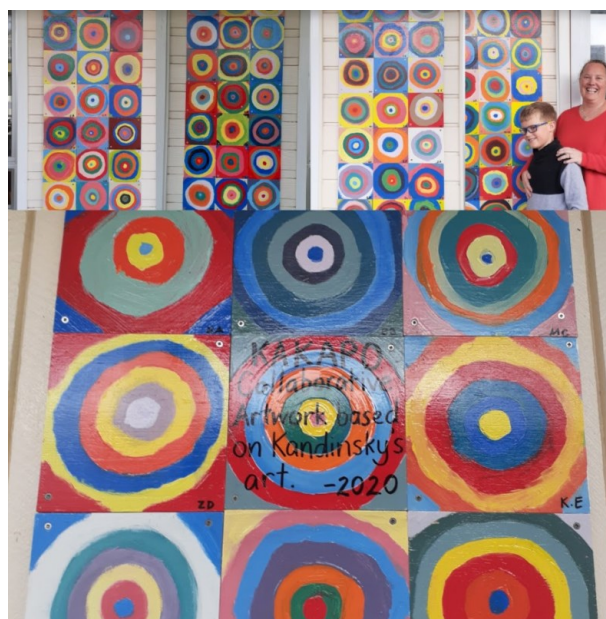

Thank you for your cooperation with the current Alert Level 2 conditions. I'm sure, like you, we are hoping that the Level 2 restrictions are only with us for another 10 days. Until we have been informed of a change in levels we will continue with our current arrangements regarding school drop off/pick up and parents entering the school grounds. We will continue to have staff at the gate in the morning and after school that are able to assist any of our students or parents.
