Out Of Zone Placements for Term 1 -2021

We have advertised for 'Out of Zone' placements for Term 1 next year. Up to 10 places are available in New Entrant - Years 1 and up to 4 places available in Y 2-6. Application forms are available from the school office. Closing date for applications is Friday 25th September. The number of actual places that we accept is determined by the number of 'in zone' enrolments and siblings of current 'out of zone' children. It is very important that we know of all children that will be starting school next year that are in zone, also any siblings starting in 2021 of current students.
