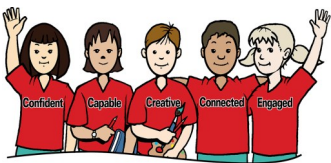

Out Of Zone Placements for Term 1 - 2021

We have advertised for 'Out of Zone' placements for Term 1 next year. Up to 10 places are available in New Entrants and Year 1, up to 4 places available in Years 2-6. Application forms are available from the school office. Applications close next Friday (25th September). The number of actual places that we accept is determined by the number of 'in zone' enrolments and siblings of current 'out of zone' children. It is very important that we know of all children that will be starting school next year that are in zone, also any siblings starting in 2021 of current students. If you have a child under 5 and you are not sure whether we have them on our pre-enrolment list, can you please contact the school office to ensure we have the correct details. Also if you know of any families that live within our school zone and have a child starting school in 2021 that might not be on our pre-enrolment list, asking them to contact the school office would be appreciated. This information really helps us with class organisation.
