THE CREATION OF THE BIKE RACKS

We talked to the Let's Go Leaders from last year and Hannah from NPDC about what we could do to help the Welbourn kids get to and from school. We thought of making bike racks for the seniors to encourage people to bike to school more because sometimes when there are a lot of bikes it is hard when they have no stands. We measured the bike shed to figure out how big the racks had to be. The wood was supplied by the Fenton Family. One Friday we went over to Highlands and met Mr Sleep. We measured and used a hand saw to cut. When we finished using the hand saw we used a pencil and ruler to draw lines on the top right and bottom right corners of small rectangles of wood and then Mr Sleep used a machine to cut them. We found it tricky to cut! We had to measure where the planks went so they could fit in correctly and fit the wheels. We have 2 more to do and scooter racks. Come and check them out. We think they're amazing!!
