R1-8: Happiness Heroes. Learning to be KINDNESS HEREOS. Being kind to themselves and others and ways they can be a good friend.
R9-11: Relationships & Resilience. Learning to understand their our own emotions and their responses & reactions to others. Learning to manage these in a positive way.
R12-15: Digital Wellbeing. Learning about their online behaviour and how they can affect themselves and others. Understanding the impact of their online decisions.
