There is still an opportunity for you to Sponsor a Bike?

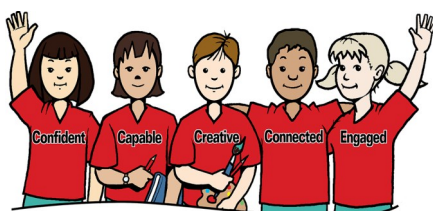
